BOOSTER DOSES ELIGIBILITY TO ADULTS AGED 50+ Starting on Monday, December 13, 2021 at 8:00 a.m., individuals aged 50 and over will be eligible to schedule their booster dose appointment through the COVID-19 vaccination portal. Appointments will be booked for approximately six months (168 days) after a second dose. SECTION 22 CLASS ORDER which legally requires anyone in the Timiskaming Health Unit (THU) area who has confirmed or suspected COVID-19 infection or who is identified as a close contact to follow isolation requirements and other public health direction. **People who do not comply with Section 22 Class order may be issued a set fine of \$880 or a provincial offence which carries a maximum fine of \$5,000 per day.**
