The Timiskaming Health Unit Recommends Caution during the Holidays as COVID-19 Case Numbers Remain

High. High COVID-19 case numbers and the arrival of the Omicron variant in Ontario have prompted Acting Officer of Health Dr. Glenn Corneil to issue a letter outlining recommendations for how residents can protect themselves and their loved ones from COVID-19 during the holidays.

The letter strongly recommends the following:

- Everyone should limit social gatherings at private dwellings to no more than 10 people indoors and 25 people outdoor. All attendees 12 years of age and older should be vaccinated.
- All unvaccinated individuals 12 years of age and older should avoid any non-essential indoor contact with individuals who are not part of their household.
- Where possible, individuals should work remotely.

The recommendations come into effect immediately and will be reassessed in four weeks.
