1. Call to Order and Approval of Agenda:

3. Business Arising from Past Minutes:

(A) COVID-19 UPDATE:

- Ontario has extended the Declaration of Emergency to June 30th, and the Canada-US border will be closed until at least June 21, 2020.
- The Province is currently re-opening on a very gradual basis. Details of the "Stage 2" restart phase will be released in the coming week.

(B) HQ AND VHF SERVICES 2020:

- The TLA HQ Building will be open on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays from noon to 4:00 p.m. and staffed by Peter Healy.
- Peter will make daily VHF broadcasts at 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. either from the HQ or his cottage.
- HQ visitors will be required to follow safety protocols, including: a limited number of visitors at any one time; wearing face masks; and, social distancing.
- Wi-Fi will be available 24/7 in July and August. The service can be used outside the front of the building when the HQ is not open.
- The VHF network extension unit will be purchased shortly from JPS and will allow broadcasting capabilities from locations other than the HQ.
- Rob will assist Peter Healy in setting this up.

(C) TEMAGAMI FOOD BANK APPEAL AND DONATION:

- A \$1,000.00 donation was made to the Temagami Food Bank on May 27, 2020.
- The TLA is awaiting news regarding the border reopening before distributing a previously-drafted appeal to members about the food bank, as this will greatly affect the economic impact on the Temagami economy.
- This will be tabled for further discussion at a later date.

(D) MEMBERSHIP DIRECTORY 2020:

- Linda is currently reviewing the initial proof of the TLA's electronic Membership Directory for 2020.
- This will be finalized and distributed to members in the next couple of weeks.
- Linda will provide details to the Board regarding security options for the document.

4. New Business:

(A) INSURANCE ADD-ON RE: BREACH OF DATA AND INTERNET-BASED COMMUNICATION LIABILITY:

- The TLA's existing liability policy *does not* respond to claims arising out of a security breach of personal information from computer data or internet communication activity (see cover letter from Cade Associates Insurance Brokers Limited dated May 19, 2020).
- This will be investigated and tabled for further discussion at a later date.

(B) ADDITIONAL PROPERTY PATROLS (SUMMER 2020):

• If the border stays closed past the June 21st deadline, Summer property patrols will be offered for current members who wish to pay for the added service.

(C) SANDY INLET PROPERTY LISTING:

- A 35-acre Ferguson Mountain waterfront acreage (patented land) has again been listed for sale at \$249,000.00 (by Barry Graham).
- The status of this will be monitored for the time being.

(D) LAKE-CAPACITY STUDY BY MUNICIPAL COUNCIL:

- The Municipal Council is considering a lake-capacity study. This may be in response to the TFN objection regarding proposed amendments to the current OP.
- At a recent Council meeting, a resolution was made to get a quote from the Municipal planners (MHDC) re: including other local lakes (in addition to Lake Temagami) in the capacity study.

(E) TLA ADVOCACY FOR CANADA/US BORDER OPENING:

- A TLA member has requested that the Board of Directors advocate for re-opening of the Canada/US border on behalf of US property owners on Lake Temagami.
- Linda sent him a list of relevant Federal ministers so that he may also contact them.
- Brit recently contacted FOCA about this issue. Currently, FOCA does not have a specific plan to address this.
