THE TIMISKAMING HEALTH UNIT DISTRICT ZONE IS RED – Friday March 26, 2021, the Timiskaming Health Unit District moved into the Red - Control level of Ontario's COVID-19 response framework. Your business may be required to make changes to your COVID-19 precautions <https://www.timiskaminghu.com/>

Changes to our district's zone in the framework are not made lightly and are made by the government of Ontario in consultation with the Timiskaming Health Unit. Factors that are considered include the level of virus circulating within our community, the capacity of our hospitals and other healthcare partners, and the ability of public health to properly follow-up with cases of COVID-19 and their contacts in a timely manner.
