A Province-Wide Declaration of Emergency and A Stay-At-Home Order are in effect as of April 8 at 12:01 A.M. The Covid-19 Response Framework (Colour-Coded Zones) is paused during this time. For more information please visit <u>Https://Covid-19.Ontario.Ca/Index.Html</u>

This order is requiring everyone to remain at home except for essential purposes, such as going to the grocery store or pharmacy, accessing health care services (including getting vaccinated), for outdoor exercise, or for work that cannot be done remotely. As Ontario's health care capacity is threatened, the Stay-at-Home order, and other new and existing public health and workplace safety measures will work to preserve public health system capacity, safeguard vulnerable populations, allow for progress to be made with vaccinations and save lives. In addition, the province is also strengthening public health and workplace safety measures for non-essential retail under the provincewide emergency brake.

You can book your vaccine appointment through the provincial online booking portal if you:

- are 60 years or older in this calendar year
- have a green Ontario photo health card (OHIP) (expired cards will be accepted)
- have an email address or cell phone number
- have a modern web browser such as Chrome or Firefox (the booking site is not compatible with Internet Explorer 11 or earlier versions)

If there are no available local vaccination appointments on the provincial booking portal, please check back at a later date. Once more vaccine supply is distributed locally, more appointment spots will get added. If there are no appointments left in your community, the site will direct you to the clinic closest to you.
