As more contagious variants continue to pose significant risks, Ontario has extended the Stay-at-Home Order until at least June 2, 2021. All public health and workplace safety measures under the province wide emergency brake will also remain in effect.

The next mass vaccination clinic for people 18 years of age and older will take place on June 1st, 2021 at the Temagami Arena from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please call the Temagami Family Health Team 705-569-3244 to schedule an appointment if you haven't already done so as there are still appointment times available.

On June 15th, 2021 from 3 to 5 p.m. a vaccination clinic has been scheduled at the Temagami Arena to accommodate school aged children between the ages of 12 and 17. Please note that in order to be eligible, the child is required to already be 12 at the time of the vaccination. If there are parents out there with questions or concerns about having their child vaccinated, please call the Temagami Family Health Team at (705) 569-3244 and ask to speak to the team's Nurse Practitioner Nancy Presseault. Please note that Pfizer will be the vaccine given at all mass vaccination clinics going forward for 1st doses.

For anyone anxiously awaiting a call to schedule their 2nd vaccine, the health unit is awaiting confirmation of Moderna supply. Once they have a sightline on supply, an announcement will be made and they will be notifying primary care for help to schedule appointments accordingly.
