
TEMAGAMI FOREST 2019-2029 FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Ontario Ministry of Northern Development, Mines, Natural Resources and Forestry (NDMNRF), First Resource Management Group Inc. (FRMG) and the North Bay District Local Citizens' Committee (LCC) invite you to review a minor amendment to the 2019-2029 Forest Management Plan (FMP) for the Temagami Forest and to provide comments.

This amendment provides for:

• Addition of a primary road corridor (Spring Lake Road) for 2.26 km.

Comments and/or concerns from those affected by the operations with respect to this minor amendment must be received within the 15-day review period and no later than **February 17, 2022** by Francisco Murphy, R.P.F. of the North Bay NDMNRF Office, see contact information below. If no concerns have been raised following the 15-day review period, the minor amendment will be approved. After approval the amendment will remain on the Natural Resources Information Portal for the duration of the FMP at https://nrip.mnr.gov.on.ca/s/fmp-online.
