Council Meeting June 8, 2023

Your Council met in a Regular Session on June 8, 2023. Council received a presentation from Ontario Power Generation regarding hydro opportunities in North East Ontario.

The Navigational Aids for Lake Temagami contract was awarded to Temagami Electrical Services for a three year term at a price \$34,425.

Council agreed to be the qualified donee for applications made to the Temagami Community Foundation for the Temagami Lions Club and the Temagami Public School projects. As well, two municipal projects for the Recreation Department and the Temagami Police Services Board were approved. The Temagami Community Foundation has been the source of funding for many worthwhile community projects over the years.

While on the subject of funding, Council directed Staff to apply for funding through the Ontario Trillium Foundation for the next phase of revitalizing the Temagami Community Centre Outdoor Complex. If the approved this fully funded grant would be \$150,000.

Council enacted the By-Laws associated with the annual budget. The taxes levied are 8% higher than last year resulting in a 7.15% increase in the tax rate. Charges for services such as water, sewer and garbage collection were also approved based on cost recovery.

Prior to the pandemic, the Municipality and the School Board had an agreement to share facilities. Council approved the Reciprocal Use of Facilities agreement with DSB One which renews this sharing notion ensuring there are more facilities available to the students at Temagami Public School as well as facilities that can be used for community recreation and other purposes.

Council received a report on a recent tax sale and directed Staff to commence with the vesting of the property. Once vested, the property could be sold subject to the Municipal Sale of Land Policy.

Council also approved the process to transfer accounts receivable to tax accounts once they remain unpaid for 90 days.

Council's next Working Session is scheduled for June 22, 2023 which will include information on RFPs planned to be issued, municipal land use by-law and further information on properties held over from the April 27th working session. MPAC is expected to address Council at this meeting as well.
