Regular Meeting of Council Highlights February 8, 2024

Your Council met in a Regular Session on February 8, 2024 at 6:30pm.

Mayor Dan O'Mara will provide a report at the next meeting regarding the business of that Closed Sessions of Council held on January 16, 2024 and January 25, 2024.

Economic Development Officer John Shymko will be making an application to the Rural Enhancement Fund (NOHFC) to seek funding for a Temagami community Centre and Arena maintenance plan.

Council has approved that two (2) Councilors and one (1) Staff member attend the Federation of Northern Ontario Municipalities (FONOM) Conference to be held May 6, 2024 to May 8, 2024 in Sudbury.

The Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) Conference will be held in August of 2024 where two (2) Councilors and one (1) Staff member will be attending.

The Fire Pump Subsidy Program was discussed by Council with a recommendation that it be referred to the Budget Committee and staff were directed to log the applications in order of submission. Once the budget has been passed applicants will be notified of Councils decision.

Acting Administrator/Treasurer Sabrina Pandolfo made a report to Council regarding the Ontario Trillium Foundation grant and requested that Council approve the application for upgrades to the Temagami Community Centre and Arena. Council approved this request and has directed staff to proceed.

Temagami Non-Profit Housing Corporation made a request to Council to wave the fees associated with a Minor-Variance application and any legal fees associated with said application. Council has approved this request.

Committee members were appointed to both the Ad Hoc Committee of Council regarding the Mine Landing Transfer Station and the Ad Hoc Committee of Council regarding Administration of Parking Stalls. Committee meetings will resume shortly.
