**Regular Meeting of Council Highlights
March 14, 2024**

Your Council met in a Regular Session on March 14, 2024 at 6:30pm.

Deputy Mayor Koistinen provided an update on the proposed HR Policy.

Acting Administrator/Treasurer Sabrina Pandolfo provided a report on the following Closed Sessions of Council:

- Closed Session February 22, 2024 - Regarding a potential employment contract.
- Closed Session March 5, 2024 - Regarding an FOI request/response.

Jamie Robinson from MHBC provided Council with an update regarding the Official Plan and its approval status.

John Tarantino from Marmak provided Council with a report regarding the progress that the Municipality is making towards the Asset Management compliance deadline in July of this year.
