#### (A) UPDATE ON TLA HEADQUARTERS BUILDING LUP:

- The focus of the discussion will be the LUP. If time permits, other topics of may include water quality, invasive species and boat-washing options, and illegal access points on the Lake (e.g., at Baie Jeanne).

#### 6. New Business:

## (A) COMMITTEE UPDATES:

Natural Resources and Environment:

- Diane attended the Invasive Species Centre annual web forum. Speakers from the MNRF discussed recent updates to the *Invasive Species Act* and the use of eDNA.
- The MNRF has information for cottagers on how to remove Eurasian Watermilfoil at their properties, which could be presented to TLA members (e.g., at the summer BBQ).
- Diane provided comments to the Committee of Adjustment on a consent application being considered for Net Lake. Its lake-capacity study showed less-than-required oxygen levels, which should trigger a 300-m setback for septic systems (as per current provincial policy).
- Diane continues to investigate options for boat washing (i.e., purchasing/renting a pressurewashing machine). She is also looking into grants that may be available for this purpose.
- Action Item: Diane will send a letter about the need for a boat-washing station(s) to Graydon Smith (Minister of Natural Resources and Forestry), Dan O'Mara and Margaret Youngs (Municipal Council), and Mike Molyneaux (Temagami First Nation).

# (B) OP AND MUNICIPAL UPDATE:

- Temagami Council is still waiting for the second draft of the Official Plan (OP) from MHBC, as input from the TFN/TAA is forthcoming.
- John Shymko (the Municipal Economic Development Officer) brought forward a proposal at the last Council meeting to purchase an electronic parking system for the Access Road landing.

## (C) MUNICIPAL TAX-ANALYSIS INITIATIVE:

#### (D) BOARD COMMENTS RE: "ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION" AND TLA BY-LAWS:

 Board members were asked to review the current TLA "Articles of Incorporation" ("Letters Patent") and 2011 by-laws and provided suggested revisions to Linda by Monday, March 4<sup>th</sup>. • In addition to the changes required by *ONCA*, these revisions will be incorporated into the updated versions of these documents that will be completed in 2024.
