

Update on TLA Headquarters Building (September 2024)

The Ministry of Natural Resources has granted a one-year extension to the land-use permit for the TLA's Headquarters (HQ) building. It now ends on December 31, 2025 and will not be renewed going forward.

Accordingly, we will likely seek a new physical home for our HQ. If you have any suggestions in this regard, please send them to Executive Director, Linda Bangay, or TLA President, Nicole Brooker.

The TLA will be required to take down the Headquarters building, shed, and privy, remove the septic system, and cap the well to "rehabilitate" the existing site. The money in our investment account will more than cover the costs of completing these tasks. A suitable contractor has been found and will begin work in 2025.

In the meantime, some items in the building (e.g., furniture, appliances, odds and ends) will be sold or given away to TLA members. A list of items is available upon request. Please let us know if there is anything that interests you.
